GENERAL INFORMATION

Drop/Add Classes:

Students can make schedule changes through the 10th day of class for a full-semester class and through the fifth day of class for a P.O.T. 2 or 3 class, via Banner (see calendar deadline dates). After the 10th day for a full-semester class and after the fifth day for P.O.T. 2 or 3 class, all schedule changes will be made via a drop/add form available at the Office of the Registrar or online via the Office of the Registrar web page. See catalog for late registration fees.

It is the **student's responsibility** to return the form to the Office of the Registrar complete with the instructor and advisor signatures.

Repeat a Class:

Notify the Office of the Registrar when repeating a class. Classes may be repeated if the grade earned was a C- or below, or a U. All classes attempted remain on the student's transcript; only the last grade is computed into the GPA and credit is earned only once. Transfer classes repeated at Concordia will be excluded from credit and GPA calculations.

Change of Major, Minor, or Advisor:

Complete a change form available on the Office of the Registrar web page or at the Office of the Registrar.

Metro College Alliance:

Degree-seeking Concordia students may take up to two classes per semester at MSUM, MState, NDSU, or NDSUS if the class is not cataloged/

offered at Concordia. Grades and credits earned will apply to the Concordia GPA. The Metro College Alliance option is not available during the summer.

Graduating Seniors:

It is required that students submit a completed Application for Graduation by the deadline date as listed on this calendar to participate in the Commencement ceremony. Complete the application form available on the Office of the Registrar's web page or at the Office of the Registrar. A student **will not be listed** on the Commencement program without having submitted this form by the deadline.

Academic Transcripts:

Instructions for obtaining official transcripts are available at ConcordiaCollege.edu/Transcripts. Official transcripts **will not be issued** until satisfactory settlement is made of all accounts with the college. Current students can print unofficial transcripts in Banner.

Classes during Symposium, MLK, and COSS:

If campus events are scheduled during class time, classes convene at the event. If not, classes are held as usual.

Current Students:

Student class schedules, the Degree Works audit program, obtaining verification of enrollment and printing an unofficial transcript are all accessible through Banner.
