SCHOLARSHIPS + AID

Every family's financial situation is unique — and your financial aid experience should be too. That's why Concordia's comprehensive financial aid packages are **customized** for each student based on their individual circumstances and financial need.

Filing the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (**FAFSA**) is the first step in securing federal grants, loans, and additional need-based aid. Concordia's FAFSA code is **002346**.

SCHOLARSHIPS FOR EVERY STUDENT

At Concordia, every student is automatically awarded an Excellence Scholarship ranging from \$13,000 to \$19,000 per year (based on GPA or test score).

PAYING FOR COLLEGE

At Concordia, **every** student receives a scholarship, bringing Concordia's average net price in line with the public school national average — and nearly **40% lower** than the private college national average.



Concordia's four-year guarantee minimizes college expenses while **providing support** for students to stay on track academically. This allows Cobbers to start pursuing their career or graduate school goals **earlier** than their peers attending other colleges and universities.



The Concordia Promise

As a part of Concordia's commitment to making education more accessible, the Concordia Promise will cover tuition for students from **ANY** U.S. state with an Adjusted Gross Income under \$90,000.

Qualifying students who applied by Dec. 1 were automatically accepted into the program; all other applicants considered until **May 1**.
