## Automatic Excellence Awards

Up to **\$17,000** per year based on EITHER test score or high school GPA — whichever is greater.

## Presidential Scholarship

Sponsored by the National Alumni Board, this scholarship is Concordia's most prestigious academic award. Eligible students will be invited to the Presidential Scholarship Event on campus in January 2024.

## Talent Scholarships

Available for Music, Speech, Theatre, and Visual Arts. These scholarships range in value and require separate applications and, in some cases, performance submissions.

**Deadline:** Feb. 1

## STEM Scholarships

The STEM Discovery and CLIMB Scholarships are need-based scholarships open to students passionate about pursuing a STEM-related career rooted in the natural sciences. Scholarships range from \$6,500 to \$15,000 annually.

## Transfer Scholarships

Up to **\$17,000** per year in Excellence Scholarships. Transfer students are eligible for a variety of scholarships. Award amounts and application process may vary slightly from first-year students.

## Alumni Referral Grant

**\$500** per year. Students referred by Cobber alumni or staff will receive a \$500 annual grant totaling \$2,000. Cannot be combined with Legacy Grant.

**Deadline:** Dec. 1

## Concordia Alumni Legacy Grant

**\$500** per year. Awarded to students whose siblings are current students or graduates, or whose parents or grandparents are alumni of Concordia College in Moorhead.
