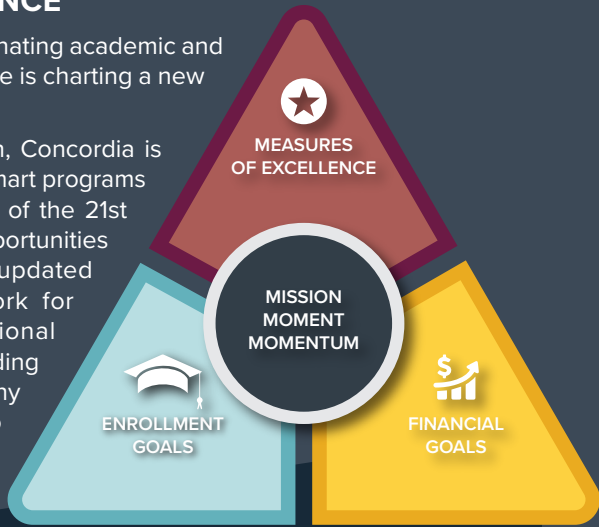

► HEIMARCK CENTER DEDICATION

Concordia College celebrated the opening of the Heimarck Center, a state-of-the-art facility for the Sanford Heimarck School of Health Professions, with a ceremony attended by a community eager to see the college’s commitment to healthcare education.
