APPLICATION PROCESS

- Apply for admission and be accepted to Concordia College.
- Complete the online CAS application by Jan. 15 and submit the required 3-5 minute video essay.
- File your Free Application for Student Aid (FAFSA) for 2025-26 and demonstrate financial need. Concordia's FAFSA code: 002346
