APPLICATION STEPS

- Complete the free online application at ConcordiaCollege.edu/Apply or CommonApp.org
- Submit your college transcripts from any postsecondary school you've enrolled in
- Request your official high school transcript if you have less than 60 earned college credits (contact your school for instructions)

Once all materials are received, admission decisions are made within 10 days.

PRESIDENTIAL SCHOLARSHIP

One incoming transfer student will be selected to receive this \$25,000 annual scholarship, Concordia's most prestigious academic award. Must apply to Concordia and be admitted by March 15. No separate application needed; qualified students will be invited to participate. Students who participate will earn the \$1,000 Presidential Scholarship to recognize their academic achievements.

EXCELLENCE SCHOLARSHIPS

Concordia offers transfer student scholarships based on academic performance. For Fall 2025, transfer students will be eligible for up to \$18,000 in automatic merit awards. Simply apply for admission; no separate application needed.

TALENT SCHOLARSHIPS

Concordia offers additional scholarship opportunities for students participating in music, speech and debate, theatre, or visual arts. These scholarships range in value and require separate applications and, in some cases, performance submissions by Feb. 1, 2025. Students selected to receive these awards will be expected to participate in events and programs as determined by the respective departments.

CONGREGATIONAL SCHOLARSHIP

Concordia will match congregational scholarships up to \$500 per year for full-time students.

CONCORDIA ALUMNI LEGACY GRANT

This \$500 annual grant is awarded to students whose siblings are current students or graduates, or whose parents or grandparents are alumni of Concordia College.

ALUMNI REFERRAL GRANT

This \$500 annual grant is awarded to students who have been referred by a Concordia College graduate.
