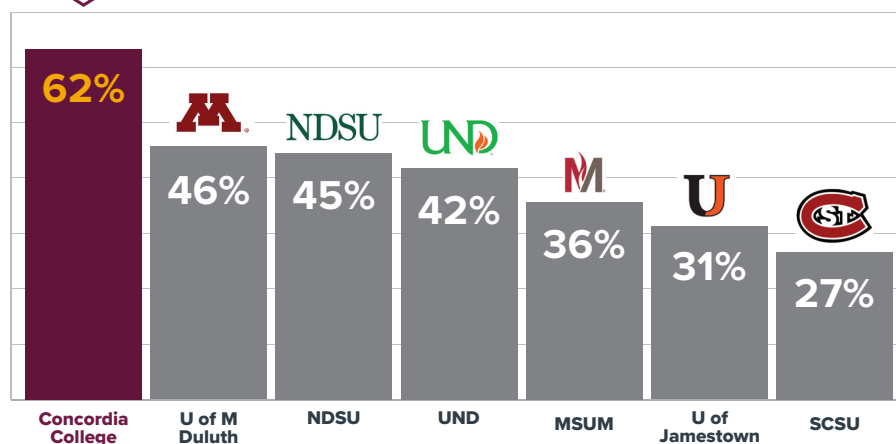
Average Net Price of Tuition, Housing, and Food
