### EXCELLENCE IN ACTION

Concordia saw its largest **two-year enrollment growth** since 2017-2018.

WalletHub ranked Concordia a **Top 5 college** in Minnesota.

300-plus undergraduates presented **original research** at the URSCA Symposium.

Concordia’s **medical school acceptance rate** is twice the national average.

A Concordia education transforms lives — and we are committed to ensuring it remains accessible for every student who can see themselves as a Cobber.

### Our Commitment to Access

- **Every student receives a scholarship.**  
This year, students received **\$13,000-\$19,000 per year** in merit awards.
- This brings Concordia's **average net price** in line with national public schools and nearly **40% below** the national private-college average.

### Average Net Price (Tuition + Housing + Food)

- **Concordia:** \$22,000
- National Public Average: \$20,780
- National Private Average: \$36,150
