# DIG DEEPER

## JUNIOR YEAR

### FALL/WINTER

- Register and take the PSAT (usually scheduled for October). Write down your educational and personal goals.
- Attend local college fairs and meet with college representatives visiting your high school.
- Make a list and begin visiting colleges that offer the programs of study that interest you. Get the most out of your experience by preparing questions in advance that reflect your goals and interests.
- Research colleges online and pay special attention to admission requirements.

### SPRING

- While Concordia offers a test-optional application, it can help your search process by signing up to take the ACT or SAT — or both. Concordia's codes are 2104 (ACT) and 6113 (SAT).
- Take Advanced Placement tests, if applicable.
- Ask your school counselor about spring and summer college fairs.
- Schedule on-campus visits.

### SUMMER

- Explore your interests and build your resume by working, volunteering, or enrolling in educational programs.
- Using the information you've gained, refine your list of schools so you're ready for another round of more in-depth visits when your senior year starts.
- Apply to your narrowed list of colleges. Applying to Concordia College is free online at [ConcordiaCollege.edu/Apply](http://ConcordiaCollege.edu/Apply) or [CommonApp.org](http://CommonApp.org).
- Seek out college prep opportunities. Your school counselor is a key resource for this, too.

## SENIOR YEAR

### FALL

- If you still need to take or retake the ACT or SAT, consider registering for one of the upcoming test dates.
- Schedule fall college visits where you can eat on campus, attend classes, meet with coaches and admission representatives, visit with students and faculty, and more.
- File the FAFSA as soon as possible after Oct. 1 at [fafsa.gov](http://fafsa.gov) to determine additional financial opportunities.
- Submit a completed application file, including your transcript and optional test scores, as early as possible.
- Watch for talent scholarship deadlines at [ConcordiaCollege.edu/Scholarships](http://ConcordiaCollege.edu/Scholarships).

### WINTER

- Research more financial aid options at [MappingYourFuture.org](http://MappingYourFuture.org) or [CollegeBoard.com](http://CollegeBoard.com).
- Talk with family, friends, teachers, coaches, pastors, and others about your top colleges to get their insights.
- Apply for Concordia College talent scholarships, if you haven't already.
- Attend scholarship events, if applicable.
- Schedule visits to your final college choices.
- Begin to finalize your college plans.

### SPRING

- Discuss your financial aid with college admission representatives and financial aid staff.
- Send in your enrollment deposit and complete your housing contract, if you haven't already.
- Take any remaining Advanced Placement tests, if applicable.

### SUMMER

- Submit the online student registration inventory.
- Attend Summer Orientation to finalize your class schedule.
- Connect with your new roommate. Coordinate who is bringing what to your residence hall.
- If you are a student-athlete playing a fall sport, keep in touch with your college coaches as you may move into your residence hall early.
- Complete all of your next steps for enrollment at [ConcordiaCollege.edu/Accepted](http://ConcordiaCollege.edu/Accepted).
- Start packing using our handy list at [ConcordiaCollege.edu/Packing](http://ConcordiaCollege.edu/Packing).
