The Language Training Centers Program is an initiative sponsored by the Defense Language and National Security Education Office and administered by the Institute of International Education. Concordia is one of seven LTCs in the nation and was established in 2016. Our partners currently are the 300th MI Brigade of the Utah National Guard, the 16th Air Force of San Antonio, Texas, the 1st Special Forces Command at Ft. Bragg, North Carolina, Air Force Culture and Language Center, Army/FORSCOM, and the Defense Language Institute Foreign Language Center at Monterey, California. We specialize in iso-immersion training and have tutoring options and language, regional expertise, and culture coursework. Programs offered reflect the express requirements of those LTC partners and are available to all U.S. military personnel.

GAIN PROFICIENCY FASTER

Program assessment shows 73% of intermediate-level speakers improved at least one sublevel on the ACTFL proficiency scale for speaking, based on OPIc testing at the beginning and end of the immersion.

EXPERIENCE AUTHENTIC CULTURE

Concordia's intensive immersions provide opportunities for deep cultural learning. The curricular content is updated in real time to reflect current events and issues. Participants develop cultural intelligence unequaled in other learning environments.

ENGAGE WITH MULTIPLE PERSPECTIVES

A participant-to-instructor ratio of 3:1 and a blend of formal and informal conversational opportunities guarantee an intensive and authentic learning experience. The daily schedule encompasses 10+ hours of active learning. Students **live the language** while building confidence and competence. Learners readily apply knowledge, skills, and expertise to real-life situations in the target language.

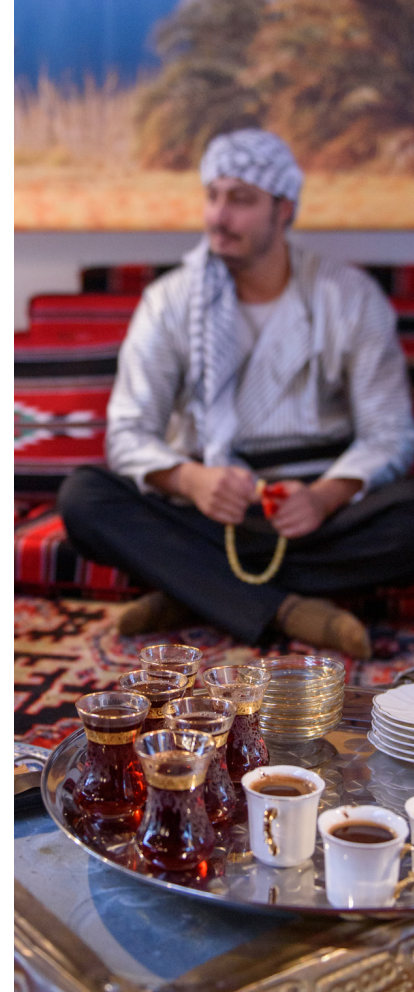


SITUATED LEARNING

Through the iso-immersion experience, participants focus on learning an average of 10 hours per day, including an intentional mix of formal and structured informal immersion program elements, guided by a blend of native speakers and highly proficient U.S.-based instructors. With an overall participant-to-instructor ratio of 3:1, programs provide extensive opportunities to engage and find support in the learning process. This full immersion creates an environment for accelerated learning and advancing linguistic as well as cultural competencies. Courses target students aiming to achieve 2+ and higher on the next DLPT. The Concordia Language Villages iso-immersion model builds competence and confidence.
