Joe Burgum leads **Folkways**, a nonprofit grounded in the belief that shared experiences — markets, public spaces, cultural gatherings — strengthen community belonging and reduce isolation. Folkways aims for a region with the **highest levels of community participation** and the **lowest rates of loneliness and suicide in the nation**, pursuing this mission through placemaking, arts activation, small-business development, and programming that brings people together across differences.
