A REMINDER FROM THE FINANCIAL AID OFFICE

It is important that you complete a Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) every year. Financial aid resources are limited and, to ensure full consideration, it is recommended you file your FAFSA by April 15 each year. The Financial Aid Office uses the FAFSA results to determine your eligibility for financial aid, including student loans such as Direct PLUS, Subsidized and Unsubsidized Direct, or private loans.

If you have not filed your 2021-22 FAFSA yet, please do so immediately.

For the 2021-22 academic year, you may submit your FAFSA as early as Oct. 1, 2020, using your 2019 income information. Using the prior year tax information will allow you and your parents to use the IRS data retrieval to import the tax data on your FAFSA, which reduces your chance of being selected for verification. Concordia's FAFSA school code is 002346.

DINING PLANS

**We have seven dining plans available. The Maroon 205 is included in the price estimate above, on-campus students who do not select a dining plan are automatically enrolled in that plan. The prices, listed per semester, are as follows:

UNLIMITED – \$2,925/semester Unlimited access to Anderson Commons plus \$100 Dining Dollars/10 guest passes and travel meals (available to all students)

GOLD 255 – \$2,720/semester 255 entries/semester (17 per week) plus \$125 Dining Dollars/8 guest passes (available to all students)

MAROON 205 – \$2,600/semester 205 entries/semester (13.66 per week) plus \$150 Dining Dollars/6 guest passes (available to all students)

KERNEL 165 – \$2,275/semester 165 entries/semester (11 per week) plus \$175 Dining Dollars/4 guest passes (available to second year, upperclass, apartment and off-campus students)

COBBER 110 – \$1,725/semester 110 entries/semester (7.33 per week) plus \$200 Dining Dollars/2 guest passes (available to upperclass, apartment and off-campus students)

SWEET CORN 85 – \$1,185/semester 85 entries/semester (5.66 per week) (available to apartment and off-campus students)

NIBLET 45 – \$640/semester 45 entries/semester (3 per week) (available to apartment and off-campus students)

BOOSTER 25 – \$360/25 meals 25 entries added to any meal plan anytime during the semester

PAYMENT

Payment for fall semester 2021 is due Aug. 15 and payment for spring semester 2022 is due Jan. 15. Interest (8% annual rate) is charged on fee statement charges if not paid in full by the due date. Registration for future semesters may not be permitted until past due balances are paid.

WAYS TO PAY YOUR FEES

- Cash – in Business Office
- Check/Money order – in Business Office or via mail
- Electronic check (checking or savings) – online (free service)
- Credit Card via PayPath (American Express, Discover, MasterCard or VISA) – online (A convenience fee of 2.85% of the transaction amount will be assessed.)
- International Wire via Western Union – online

HOW CAN STUDENTS VIEW OR PAY STATEMENTS ONLINE?

1. Log in to CobberNet at cobbernet.cord.edu.
2. Click the TouchNet link at the top of the page.

TO VIEW YOUR STATEMENT

1. Click on the “View” button in the Statements area in the center of the page.
2. Select a statement date to view from the drop down menu.
3. Click “View.”

TO MAKE A PAYMENT

1. Click on “Make Payment” from the navigation bar.
2. Select payment (amounts are editable on the right).
3. Click “Continue.”
4. Select “Payment Method” from drop down menu and click “Select.”
5. Follow directions according to payment method.
 - a. Electronic check (Savings or Checking)
 - b. Credit card via PayPath (American Express, Discover, MasterCard or VISA)
 - c. International Wire via Western Union

ELECTRONIC REFUNDS SETUP

1. Click on the “Electronic Refunds” from the My Profile Setup area on the right side.
2. Click on “Set Up Account.”
3. Select the bank account where you wish the deposit to be sent and click “Continue” **OR** enter required information from a U.S. bank account for a new account.

Reminder: You will need to request any refunds from the Business Office. Refunds are not automatically issued.

CAN MY PARENTS VIEW OR PAY FEES ONLINE?

Yes, if you have designated them as an “Authorized User.” The student may add as many authorized users as they wish. To do this:

1. Click on the “Authorized Users” from the My Profile Setup area on the right side.
2. Enter the email address and answer the two questions.
3. Click “Continue.”
4. Your authorized user(s) will receive login instructions and a randomly generated password. After they have logged in with their email address and this password, they will be able to update a profile and choose a new password.

HOW WILL I RECEIVE MY TUITION AND FEES STATEMENTS?

All monthly statements are available online and are due the 15th of the following month. Emails will be sent to students at their Concordia email address indicating that a new billing statement is ready for viewing shortly after the 15th of each month. The email provides a link to CobberNet and once logged in, students can access the Statements by selecting the TouchNet link at the top of the CobberNet page. We strongly suggest you make your parent(s) “Authorized Users” so that they may view your monthly statement.

Summer Sessions: Statements will not be mailed, but are available electronically on CobberNet mid-May. Fees are due by June 15. Please refer to instructions above on how to view and pay online.
