SCHEDULING AN AUDITION

LESSONS

Lessons are available from Music Department Faculty to any interested student. Lessons are scheduled individually with studio faculty. Students who are selected for membership into The Concordia Band or The Concordia Orchestra are required to study privately, as are students who have received a Concordia Music Performance Scholarship. There is a cost for lessons that is added to your tuition bill.

INSTRUMENT RENTAL

There is no charge to rent an instrument as a member of a Concordia Ensemble. Please contact the music office for information about rental instruments

LOCKERS

Lockers are available to anyone who is participating in musical ensembles or taking lessons. Speak with anyone in the music office to reserve a locker. There is a one-time fee of \$10.

ENSEMBLE FEES

The college has instituted a nominal ensemble fee that is assessed for every ensemble in each semester of participation. Students participating in the Concordia Orchestra, The Concordia Choir, or the Concordia Band will be assessed a higher fee per semester.
