Blacksburg, Virginia.

Dr. Elmer and Dr. Sütterlin co-founded Sinfonietta Memphis in 2014. The chamber orchestra specializes in the research and performance of historically informed performance practice. Their academy has recently been recognized as one of the country's leading period performance practice institutes. The organization provides free concerts and music education for the Greater Memphis community.
