

The purpose of this transfer guide is to provide a smooth transition for transferring from Minneapolis Community and Technical College to Concordia College. This guide identifies previously transferred courses for: Minneapolis College Associate in Arts (AA) or Associate in Science (AS) to equivalent core requirements at Concordia College. If a course is not listed, it may not have been transferred to Concordia before. Please contact the Transfer Coordinator to have your course evaluated or with any questions.

Transferable courses must be similar to a course offered at Concordia, in which a grade of C- or better was received, and have a course number 100 or above. Credit transfer is subject to change. **Institutional and graduation requirements:** Concordia College requires a minimum of 126 semester credits, a cumulative Concordia GPA of 2.0 and a 2.0 GPA in the major. Forty senior credits (numbered 300 and above), a complete major, and completion of the Liberal Arts Core Curriculum are also required. Students graduate according to requirements published in the Concordia College Catalog at the time of their matriculation at Concordia (See current catalog for complete listing [ConcordiaCollege.edu/Catalog](http://ConcordiaCollege.edu/Catalog)).
