TRANSFER GUIDE FOR MINNEAPOLIS COMMUNITY & TECH COLLEGE

These courses have been approved for transfer to Concordia's CORE curriculum. This is a guide only for the purpose of helping you in course selection for transferring to Concordia. If a course is not listed below it does necessarily not mean that it will not transfer. Transferable courses are defined as courses that are similar to a course offered at Concordia, in which a grade of "C-" or better was received, and have a course number 100 or above. At least 40 semester credits, taken in courses numbered 300 or higher, and a minimum of 50% of the major requirements for the designated major must be Concordia coursework.
