## 2024-25 Room Rates (all rates shown are per person)

All housing fees are billed to students' fee statements at the beginning of each semester

| Room Type  | Rate             |

| Traditional Hall Double (Erickson, Fjelstad, Hallett, Hoyum, Livedalen, Park Region)             | \$2,400/semester |
| Traditional Hall Double as a Single (Erickson, Fjelstad, Hallett, Hoyum, Livedalen, Park Region) | \$3,500/semester |

## Single Occupancy Options

There are some rooms reserved on each floor of the traditional residence halls that are 'double as a single' rooms

- This means a double room where only one person is assigned
- Note that there are two sets of furnishings (bed, dresser, etc) in these rooms, and all furniture must remain in the room.
