I. <b>CRITICAL INQUIRY SEMINAR (INQ):</b> (four credit hours) In-depth courses that emphasize the process of critical inquiry and student academic success.	Transfer students with a full year of college after high school graduation and at least 24 credits are exempt from Inquiry Seminar.
II. <b>WRITTEN COMMUNICATION (IWC):</b> (four credit hours) The Written Communication course emphasizes academic writing as a way to learn, teach and participate in an academic community.	ENGL 1010 & 1020 (both needed and at least 24 post-high school transferred credits)
III. <b>ORAL COMMUNICATION (IOC):</b> (four credit hours) In the Oral Communication course, students will learn to produce and critique reasoned and informed messages in public speaking and group settings.	SPCH 1010 & 1020 (both needed and at least 24 post-high school transferred credits)
IV. <b>HOLISTIC HEALTH (PED):</b> One credit hour	No current transferrable equivalencies.
