



The federal Student Right-to-Know Act requires that colleges and universities publish their six-year graduation rates. Concordia's current six-year graduation rate is 72%. Meaning, of the new first-year students who enrolled at Concordia in 2013, 72% had graduated by 2019 (six years after first enrolling at Concordia). The remainder of the cohort had transferred, dropped out of college, or not yet completed their degree.

Ninety two percent (92%) of Concordia's 2013 new first-year students, who stayed at Concordia throughout their college career, completed their degree within four years.*
